Meet Kerin McGue: Chief Clinical Officer



Ever since she was a child, Kerin McGue knew that her passion lied in working with individuals with special abilities.

"By second grade, I was a peer mentor," she says. "I did that all throughout elementary and middle school. By high school, I was doing volunteer hours in the [special education] classroom."

Throughout her life, Kerin has served the disability community through a wide variety of avenues. From majoring in Severe Special Education in college, to getting her Master's and teaching special education, she knew that her professional life was driven by the desire to help the community.

"While I was teaching, I realized that I needed more behavioral education to effectively work with the kiddos in my class," Kerin shared. "I ended up exploring the behavior field more, and became really interested in the vocational transition to adult age. I was given the opportunity to start working with adults in 2016, and that's what I've been doing since!"

When Kerin learned about The Price Center and the opening for a Chief Clinical Officer, she knew she had to jump at the opportunity.

"I'm very mission-driven, and The Price Center's mission was [very important to me]," she said. "I'm also up for a challenge. I know that The Price Center has experienced a lot of leadership change in a short period of time, and the opportunity presented itself to bring this organization up to its [highest potential]; to make it the best in class. I'm really looking forward to that."

During her first few weeks, Kerin launched her strategic plan to get The Price Center to that place. Her "three pillars of focus" are *leadership, positive behavior supports, and quality assurance and management.* She shared that her strategic plan involves training and strengthening the leadership team, improving systems, and being a strong support system for the individuals and staff.

"Positive behavior support is my framework for this organization across all programs," she said. "We started a PBS leadership team and we're in training for that now. Jude [Ogbebor] just completed his CPI training, which will complement the PBS team well."

Outside of her love for The Price Center's mission, Kerin is happily celebrating the birth of her 10-month-old and becoming a mom.

"He takes up all my time, but he's amazing!"

Rock Your Socks for Awareness!


On Friday, March 21st, *Rock Your Socks* with The Price Center in honor of **World Down Syndrome Day!**


